## Troop 134 Summer Camp Necessities

## **Clothing:**

Full Class A Uniform: Tan BSA Shirt, neckerchief: cap, shorts, socks and belt
1 pair of Boy Scout shorts (2 if available) and 5 or 6 pair of shorts other than BSA shorts
5 pairs of scout socks and 6 white pair of socks other than BSA socks
7 T-shirts (scout related or plain colored t-shirts) and 1 to 2 Class B Troop T-Shirts
2 bathing suits (in case one is lost or torn)
7 pair of underwear
1 sweatshirt (optional in case it gets cool at night)
1 pair of hiking boots and 1 pair of tennis shoes
1 pair of pool shoes you can use your tennis shoes (no flip flops or open toed shoes)
Raingear: poncho is fine (We have used it!! !)
Laundry bag for dirty clothes
Trash bags for wet clothes, etc.

## For Swimming Merit Badge:

Long Sleeve Shirt (snap-up the front if possible) Long pants (not blue jeans) 1 pair of socks Lace up shoes for getting in the pool 1 belt (Thrift Town is a good place to get these items. Get 1 to 2 sizes larger than normal)

## **Other Gear:**

Foot Locker (Academy sales a red or black heavy duty plastic footlocker. Make sure your combo lock fits in the hole for the lock.) Combination lock (NO key locks) Scout Handbook Spiral notebook Pen / Click Pencils Pillow Cot (cot pad optional) Summer Sleeping bag or sheets and blanket (it does get cool at night!) Insect Repellant Sunscreen (Min SPF 30) Chapstick 2 Towels (Beach & Bath) Toiletries: Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, Shampoo, Hairbrush, etc. Flashlight! Extra batteries! Folding Pocket knife (to be kept in your footlocker) Make sure you have your Tot'n Chip card Folding Camp chair Water Bottle and Cup Personal First Aid Kit (small to keep in your daypack) Watch (you will have to get to your own classes) Spending Money Approx \$40 (t-shirts usually cost about \$15) Camera (optional) Daypack (must to carry things to classes, etc.) Camp games such as cards. No electronic items. Do not bring anything of value that if lost you will miss it. Bring any medications you are currently taking and be sure and mark everything with your name and troop number. Current medications should be documented on your medical forms and must be in its original container. Do not bring medication in a zip lock bag. Label everything with first and last name and Troop 134
